

g15 London moves

Do you need to move within London?

If you live in London and need to move to a smaller property; to live closer to work; to provide care; or you need to move to another area for another reason – you now have more choice.

g15 London moves is a pilot project helping social housing tenants to move around London.

Find out if g15 London moves could help you.

Moving to a different part of London has been difficult and time consuming in the past for social housing tenants.

This scheme gives you the chance for a move, while keeping terms similar to your current tenancy.

To register for the scheme you need to:

- Be willing to downsize by one bedroom or more

OR

- In employment for at least 13 weeks but the distance from your home to work is making it hard to keep your job or in full-time education linked to a firm job offer

OR

- Move to provide care to a close family member, or another person a member of your household has a demonstrable relationship with. Carers must be able to show either: that they are receiving carers allowance, or have a letter or care plan from the relevant local authority

OR

- You need to move to another area for another reason.

How it works

STEP ONE:

The first step is to register – on the website which is available from your landlord's website or at www.g15londonmoves.org.uk.

You'll be asked to provide information to prove that you are eligible for this scheme.

Am I eligible?

To register for this scheme you need to be:

- ✓ A tenant of a g15 landlord**
- ✓ A secure or assured tenant
- ✓ A tenant for at least a year

You'll also need to:

- ✓ Have a good rental payment record
- ✓ Have had no reports of anti-social behaviour in the last 12 months about anyone in your household
- ✓ Have kept your home in good condition

If you're not sure what kind of tenancy you have, you can either check your tenancy agreement or contact your landlord.

This pilot scheme is now closed to new applicants

STEP TWO:

Once you've registered you'll be able to search for homes online and bid for a home that meets your needs.

STEP THREE:

If you're eligible and find yourself at the top of a short list of bidders for the home you want, you'll have a chance to view and move to your new home, subject to the usual checks and verification of your details. You may have a new landlord, but your tenancy terms and conditions will be similar.

A g15 housing provider participating in the scheme can make no promises (nor can give any assurances) that any rehousing will result from your application.

****Am I a g15 tenant?**
